



Central California Art Association & the Mistlin Gallery Call to Artists: Autumn Art Festival 2018

The Autumn Art Festival is a CCAA members only juried art show and fundraiser at the Mistlin Gallery from August 14 – October 5. Awards will be given at the fundraiser gala on August 25th.

Jurors and Judges: Terri Wilson, Tina Moore, Jacob Weigel

Categories of Art:

Water Media: Acrylic, ink, watercolor

Oil /Pastel/Encaustic: All entries using predominantly these mediums

Graphics: Photography, digital art, drawings

Mixed Media: Any two-dimensional art with significant use of two or more mediums.

3-Dimensional: Pottery, Sculpture, fabric art, etc. that is 3 dimensional in nature.

Awards: Best of Show \$500, First Place in each category \$150, Second Place in each category \$100, Third Place in each category \$50. Merit awards to be given at jurors discretion. The Peoples' Choice awards will be announced after the August 16th and September 20th Art Walks.

Submission of Works: Submitted works of art must be physically brought into the gallery to be juried into the show. Artists will be notified by email or phone as to the status of their work on Sunday, August 12th Pieces that are not accepted need to be picked up on the dates listed below with no exceptions.

Fees and Number of Entries: Each artist may submit up to five entries at \$15 per entry and \$30 for oversize entries. All artists will receive a complimentary gala ticket at will call the night of the Gala.

August 4,5- Receiving: 11:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. Artwork to be submitted for jurying and judging (*actual artworks must be submitted for this process*)

August 11 - Jurying and judging of artwork 10:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. (lunch 1:00 pm)

August 12 - Notify artists by email or phone which works were accepted and/or awarded and which works need to be picked up.

August 12 - 13 - Curate and hang show

August 12 - 13 - Artists pick up artwork not accepted into show; 11:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.

August 14 - Show opens

August 25 - Gala and Fundraiser: 6:00 p.m. – 9:00 p.m. (Awards, banquet, music, raffle) Tickets \$30

August 16 and September 20 - 3rd Thursday Art Walks

October 5 - Show closes

October 6 - Artists pick up artwork noon – 4:00 p.m.

Guidelines for 2018 Autumn Art Festival

1. Deadline for prospectus and fees is Saturday, July 28, 2018.
2. Artwork is to be delivered to the Mistlin Gallery for jurying and judging on August 4, 5, from 11:00 AM to 4:00 PM. Artists will be notified of acceptance on Sunday, August 12.
3. Artwork not accepted may be picked up August 12, 13 from 11:00 AM TO 4:00 PM.
4. An information card that includes the title, artist name and phone number, media, price and show number needs to be affixed to the *upper left-hand side of the back of the artwork or underneath three dimensional works*. Artists may use the template for the title cards. ALL WORKS MUST BE FOR SALE.
5. Artwork placement location within the Gallery is at the discretion of the Exhibition Committee.
6. All applications are due according to prospectus instructions or at the discretion of the show host.
7. Hanging wires should be mounted 3 to 5" below the top of the frame to allow for our hanging system. This deviates from the standard 1/3 from the top of frame. Please try to make changes before submitting artwork. Plastic ties are no longer necessary. Hooks are theft-resistant.
 - Size limit: There are no size limits for two-dimensional or three-dimensional artwork, other than the discretion of the show hosts based on space available. Extra fees may apply. See prospectus or call John Wynn with questions on oversize pieces.
8. Artists with pieces weighing over fifty pounds should call John Wynn (996-8796).
9. The Central California Art Association reserves the right to remove work from display if deemed not in the best interests of the CCAA.
