Teachers, counselors, and referring agencies:

Please recommend students who are “at risk” and in danger of falling between the cracks, economically disadvantaged or in need of direction to help them make a difference in their lives. The students that you recommend are **expected to make a commitment to attend all sessions and to participate fully in the program.** We ask that you discuss with prospective applicants the level of commitment required in this program. Because of limited space we want to ensure that all those accepted will take full advantage of the opportunity. **In addition to participating in all 10 sessions, students will be expected to present and prepare an exhibition of their work, which will be accompanied by a formal reception.** Teaching artists who have an excellent rapport with youth will facilitate the classes. There will be ten classes plus an exhibit and reception. Students will be supplied with materials for the 10 week coursework. In addition, fully participating students will be given art portfolios and materials for continuing with their art practice on their own.
