



Central California Art Association & the Mistlin Gallery Call to Artists: Autumn Art Festival 2021

The Autumn Art Festival is a CCAA member-only juried art show and fundraiser at the Mistlin Gallery from August 10 – October 8. Awards are given at the fundraiser gala on September 25.

Jurors and Judges: Deborah Barr, Jon Souza and one more TBD

Categories of Art:

Water Media and Ink: Acrylic, watercolor, alcohol inks

Oil and Pastel: All entries using predominantly these mediums

Graphics: Photography, digital art, drawings (pencil and ink), printmaking, mono-prints

Mixed Media: Any two-dimensional art with significant use of two or more mediums.

3-Dimensional: Pottery, Sculpture, fabric art, etc. that is 3-dimensional in nature.

Awards: Best of Show \$500, First Place in each category \$150, Second Place in each category \$100, Third Place in each category \$50. Merit awards to be given at jurors' discretion. The Peoples' Choice awards will be announced during the August 19 and September 16 Art Walks.

Submission of Works: Works must be original, recent and created solely by the artist. Work done under classroom supervision is not acceptable. No work previously exhibited in Autumn Art Festival is allowed. Submitted works of art must be physically brought into the gallery to be juried into the show. Pieces that are not accepted need to be picked up on the dates listed below with no exceptions.

Fees and Number of Entries: Each artist may submit up to five entries at \$20 per entry, \$30 for oversize entries whose perimeters are greater than 144 inches. Membership dues are \$60 for those who are not current members. *All artists* who enter will receive one complimentary gala ticket to be picked up the night of the Gala. *These tickets are for the artist only.*

Calendar of Events:

July 27 - Deadline for submission of prospectus

July 31 - August 1 - Receiving 11:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. Artwork to be submitted for jurying and judging (*actual artworks must be submitted for this process*)

August 7 - Jurying and judging of artwork 10:00 a.m. - completion (lunch 1:00 pm)

August 8 - Notify artists by email or phone which works were accepted and/or awarded and which works need to be picked up.

August 8 - 9 - Curate and hang show

August 8 - 9 - Artists pick up artwork not accepted into show; 11:00a.m. – 4:00 pm.

August 10 - Show opens

September 25 - Awards Gala and Fundraiser: 6:00 – 9:00 p.m. (Awards, banquet, music, raffle) Tickets \$30

August 19 and September 16 - Art Walks, 5:00 - 9:00 p.m.

October 8 - Show closes

October 9 - Artists pick up artwork: noon – 4:00 p.m.

Guidelines for 2021 Autumn Art Festival
Show dates: August 10 – October 8, 2021

Entry into this show is open to all member artists 18 years of age or older. All artwork must be original. Artwork that has been shown in previous Autumn Art shows or under classroom supervision will not be accepted. All works submitted must be original pieces. This show is 7 weeks long. Selected art will remain in the gallery until October 8, 2021, unless purchased from an out-of-town buyer.

1. Deadline for prospectus and fees is Tuesday, July 27, 2021. Prospectus can be found on line at www.ccaagallery.org or at Mistlin Gallery 1015 J street Modesto, CA 95354
2. All artwork must be for sale. In this show, artwork will remain in the gallery until show ends, unless the buyer is from out of the area.
3. Artwork is to be delivered to the Mistlin Gallery for jurying and judging on July 31- August 1 from 11:00 AM to 4:00 PM. Artists will be notified of acceptance on Sunday, August 8.
4. Artwork not accepted must be picked up August 8-9, 11:00 AM– 4:00 PM.
5. An information card that includes the Title, Artist Name and phone number, Media, and Price (as shown above) needs to be affixed to the *upper left-hand side of the back of the artwork or underneath three-dimensional works*. ALL WORKS MUST BE FOR SALE.
6. Artwork placement location within the Gallery is at the discretion of the Exhibition Committee.
7. All applications are due according to prospectus instructions or at the discretion of the show host.
8. Hanging wires should be mounted 3" to 5" below the top of the frame to allow for our hanging system. This deviates from the standard 1/3 from the top of frame. Hooks are theft-resistant.
9. Artists with pieces weighing over fifty pounds should call John Wynn (996-8796)
10. Size limit: There are no size limits for two-dimensional or three-dimensional artwork, other than the discretion of the show hosts based on space available. Extra fees may apply. See Prospectus or call John Wynn with questions on oversize pieces.
11. The Central California Art Association reserves the right to remove work from display if deemed not in the best interests of the CCAA.
